ELIGIBILITY:

- Undergraduate and graduate students interested in pursuing a career in Dentistry
- Applicant must have completed their second year of undergraduate coursework or beyond
- To be competitive, the applicant should have a minimum average (GPA) of 2.5 and a science GPA of 2.5.
